The City of Oakland's Department of Human Services is currently seeking individuals to instruct children enrolled in the Head Start Program, assist in developmental assessments and organize and set up education and play materials for the classroom. You will also be expected to conduct fire, disaster and safety drills, assist in planning, organizing and scheduling daily center/classroom activities, make initial and final home visits, prepare snacks and serve meals and recruit children for enrollment.

Minimum requirements include graduation from high school or legal equivalent and one of the following: (A) A State Awarded Certificate for preschool teachers that meets or exceeds the requirements for a Child Development Associate credential; (B) Associate, baccalaureate or advanced degree in Early Childhood Education or related field, or (C) a degree in a field related to Early Childhood Education with experience in teaching preschool children and State Awarded Certificate. Additionally, you must have 24 post-secondary semester units or equivalent quarter units in early childhood education or child development that cover child growth and development, child family and community, child and family, or program/curriculum as well as 6 months of work experience in a licensed child care center or comparable group child care program.
