Monitors parent/child interaction; Reports unusual/inappropriate behaviors. Reports suspected/alleged child abuse; Maintains required documents/reports; Monitors children's transportation; Attends clinical staff meetings. Performs other duties as assigned.

Qualifications: 18 units in Early Childhood Education/Child Development and a valid Associate Teacher's Permit from the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. One to two (2) years of relevant experience in a variety of areas including: direct care of children between birth and 5 years of age; some curriculum development and implementation. Experience with children and families from diverse cultural, linguistic, and socioeconomic backgrounds required. Bilingual (English/Spanish) preferred. Ability to satisfy Title V requirements for a teacher including maintaining an Associate's Teacher Permit and a valid Pediatric First Aid and CPR certificate.

Qualifications: Teacher Permit or higher issued by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. Associate's Degree or higher in Early Childhood Education, Child Development or related field with a minimum of 24 units of ECE coursework. Working knowledge of early childhood programs standards licensing requirements and operations including prior teaching experience in an ECE classroom. Working knowledge of developmental and educational standards for children birth to five years. Demonstrated skill in curriculum development and modification for children birth to five. A valid first aid and CPR certificate or the ability to obtain one within the introductory period.
