Position Summary:

This position serves as the lead worker in the classroom of Head Start children by planning, implementing, and supervising all classroom activities. This position works with typically developing children and children with disabilities. This position also serves as a social service referral person and shares responsibility for parent involvement in the program.

Duties and Responsibilities of the position:

Attends all required training and workshops; remains up-to-date on information that pertains to the needs of the children in the program including Head Start Performance Standards, child care licensing regulations and other applicable regulations and practices. Works as team member with the other education staff, parents and Parent Committee members to develop curriculum that is meaningful and meets the individual and program needs; responsible for the weekly preparation of daily lesson plans; develops an individual plan for each child to include goal setting; schedules home visits and parent-teacher conferences with families as required; maintains strict confidentiality; prepares a safe and healthy learning environment for children that are developmentally appropriate and experientially-based.

Education and Experience:

Minimum requirements: A fully qualified teacher must have 24 units or more in ECE/CD units and a valid California Teacher Permit or AA/BA Degree in Child Development or related field with a California Teacher Permit or higher.

Physical Demands:

May be required to lift up to 45 pounds; some exposure to communicable disease
Noise level in work environment may be moderate to loud. Work is typically performed in a classroom setting and some office work required.
