### **Responsibilities:**

- 1) Provides nutrition assessments and assess nutrition needs on every child enrolled in the Kedren Head Start/ State Preschool. Reviews each child's growth data and health records and develops individualized care plan.
- 2) Provides nutrition information and education to parents, as well as parents' one on one nutrition counseling.
- 3) Develops presentations and trains both staff and parents and develops nutrition education material when needed.
- 4) Recommends, develops and implements new programs and activities.
- 5) Works hand in hand with RD Consultant, Nutrition Coordinator, Nutrition Supervisor as well as other staff.

### **Requirements:**

- 1) Have completed a minimum of a Bachelor's degree (BS) in dietetics at a regionally accredited U.S. College or University or an equivalent foreign degree.
- 2) Has completed a supervised practice program (dietetic internship).
- 3) Has passed a national credentialing exam (Registered Dietetic).
